We are working as a team with the forest engineer, a forest charity, and the village leader to plant 1,000 locus and linden trees on the sides of these mountain roads so bees can survive during the hot summer months and continue to produce honey. Honey is the primary source of income of the villagers.

It has now been decided that the sub governor will build the building to house the boiler, the parents of the school children will provide the money for the boiler. LDS charities will provide the plumbing throughout the building. The village is anxious to get the boiler working as the children are cold this time of year.



The school desk project is almost completed. This is the team that has helped make this happen. We were able to purchase 531 used desks from a bankrupted private school at a very good price and the municipality of Karabaglar picked them up at their expense and took them to their facility where they are refinishing them at their expense and is making them like new. They will then put them into schools in poor communities.
